


Adding a driver



To add a driver to the team, click on the **Add User** button. You will be redirected to a new window.

+ ADD USER






Complete the field containing the **Username**. This can be the employee's name, vehicle registration number or another form of identification - the choice is yours. This is the only mandatory field.

Username*

Fields such as **User Description**, **Phone**, **Email** and **Comments** are optional, but completing them can make managing your team easier. You do not need to complete them at this stage - you can return to edit them later. Once completed, press **Generate Code**.





Give the QR code to the driver, who should scan it with their phone or other mobile device. Once scanned, the **BINNAVI** app will be downloaded and the login panel will automatically open. The driver does not need to enter any data - just scanning the code and the app will automatically link it.

Alternatively, you can give the driver a 8-digit code, which he or she should enter on the **BINNAYI** app.






A green marker along with information about the scanned QR code will appear when the login has been carried out correctly.

After completing all these steps and ensuring that the code has been scanned or entered, press **Save**. The driver will be added to the list of users.



Step 2

Register a model route




Once you have added a driver and assigned a smartphone or other mobile device, it is time to register a model route.

Open the **BINNAVI** app and press **Register new route**.

Enter the name of the route, and then press **Start**.











Start driving - the app will automatically record your location in the background, creating a model route.

You can enrich your route with useful notes at the stops. The **notes** can be about obstacles on the road, specific pick-up locations, the organisation of work on a particular section of the route or other relevant information.











To add a note, press the **Add Note** button and enter the note content. You don't have to do this right now - you can return to edit notes later, following the instructions in the **Editing a model route** section described in Step 3.

Add note

To finish recording the **route**, press the **Finish** button and confirm whether you want to save the model route or delete it. The saved route will be added to the list of model routes, from which you can later assign it to a particular driver.


User and route editing




User editing

In the list of users, hover the cursor over the person you want to edit and then click **Edit**.









In the new window you will be able to edit the fields **User Description**, **Phone**, **Email address** and the content found in **Comments**. Once you have made your changes, press the **Save** button to confirm them.

Editing a model route

To edit a model route, go to the **Routes** tab and then select the route you are interested in by hovering over it and clicking on the **Edit** button.








In the Edit Route window you will see the **Route Name** field, which you can edit, as well as information about the **Number of notes** on the route and the **Distance** expressed in kilometres.


In the **Notes list** section, you will find all the notes added during the registering of the model route. To edit a note, hover the cursor over its content and click on the field with its content, then editing is possible.





In addition, on the right side of the screen there is a preview of the model route with the points where the notes will be displayed marked. The notes are numbered according to the order in which they are displayed.


Once you have made your changes, click **Save** to save the edited route.




Assigning model routes to drivers



To assign a route to a driver, go to the **Mobile Users** tab. Select the user to whom you wish to assign the route from the list. Hover the cursor over their name and click on **Share route**.








A new window will display a list of available model routes. When you click on a selected route, you will see a preview of the route on the map on the right side of the screen, together with the added notes.

Select the routes you want to make available to the driver, and then click on the **Save** button.


Replay model route



To replay a model route, go to the list of routes by pressing the **Routes** button.

The routes displayed were assigned and shared from the team admin panel.




The route has start and end markers. Follow the marked trail.


The parts of the route on the map that have been covered change colour.

At the bottom of the screen is a progress indicator that tells the driver how much of the model route has already been driven.





If you have added notes when recording your route, these will appear automatically as you approach the relevant location.





To see the content of any note, press the balloon icon on the map. To close a note, swipe it left or right.

When you have completed the model route or want to end the ride, press the **Finish** button.
